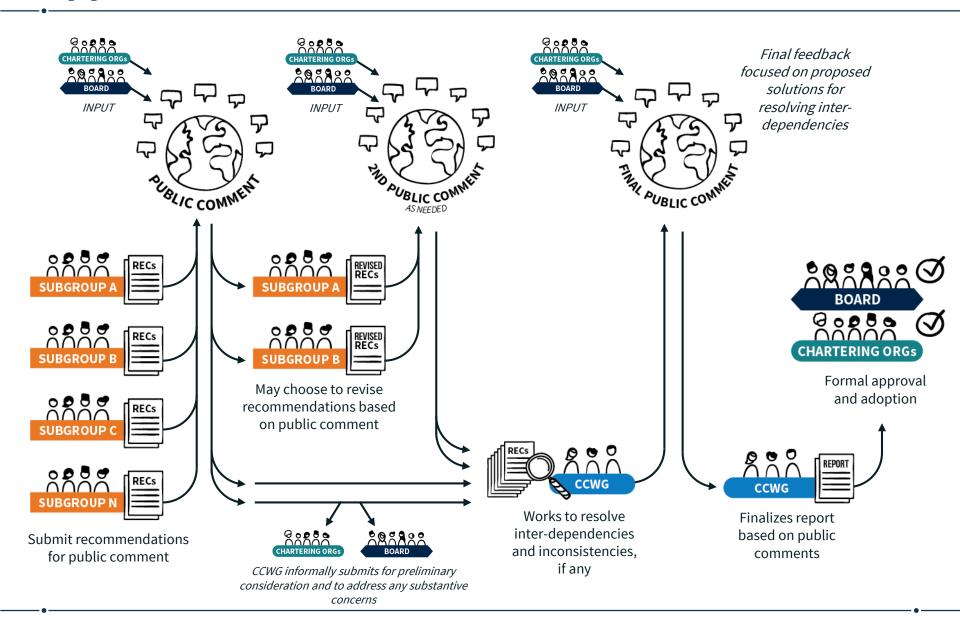


Measurement of Progress
