

WPRT: Draft Report Overview

- WHOIS Policy Review Team was formed in October 2010 (guided by AoC) to review:
 - The extent to which WHOIS policy and its implementation are effective;
 - Meet legitimate needs of law enforcement;
 - Promote consumer trust.
- WHOIS Review team developed 20 recommendations



WPRT: Highlights from the Report

- Recommendations include:
 - Single WHOIS policy
 - Making WHOIS a strategic priority
 - Improved Outreach
 - Improving Data Accuracy
 - Requirements / Penalties for Privacy Services
 - WHOIS Access
 - Development of standards for IDNs



WPRT: Development of Comments

- Feb 3rd
 - Initial call was held to discuss report with interested members
- Feb 22nd
 - Draft report was sent to all members
 - Multiple revisions made based upon feedback from several members
- Mar 7th
 - Second call held for all BC members to discuss comments
- Mar 10th
 - Final draft sent to all members



WPRT: Our Perspective

- The BC generally agrees in principle with most of the recommendations
- However, the BC also believes that many of the recommendations do not go far enough to ensure that
 - WHOIS is effective
 - Meets legitimate needs of law enforcement
 - And promotes consumer trust



SAC51: Draft Roadmap to Implement

- SSAC (Security and Stability Advisory Committee) published SAC51
 - Recommendation that the ICANN community evaluate and adopt a replacement for the WHOIS protocol which would
 - Utilize new terminology (not acronym-based) and standards
 - Supports IDNs
- Board requested a proposed roadmap for the coordination of the technical and policy discussions necessary to implement SAC51
- Envisioned that there will be two comment periods
