

Substantive issues raised and expectations

- Freedom of Expression and Right to Association
 - gTLDs and communities (.gay, health, pharmacy issues)
- Privacy
 - Data retention, WHOIS
 - ICANN is a data controller and processor
 - Registries want to engage on these issues
- Ensure ICANN does its work properly when it comes to Public Interest and Human Rights
- GAC engages on Human Rights issues, especially on bylaws and gTLDs, legal advice might be sought on bylaws

Risks & Opportunities

- The scope should be limited to keep process manageable (Human rights that are directly applicable to policies and procedures of ICANN)
- Information about intention and workflow should be clearly communicated
- Inclusion of all relevant communities from inception (Outreach to all ACs and SOs)
- Quality of analysis and sufficient is essential
