CPIF Amendments

- Why? Point H of the CPIF: “ICANN staff will continually review the implementation framework and related materials to encapsulate additional best-practices or to adjust the steps as a result of lessons learned with previous Consensus Policy projects.
- 5 Stages to CPIF:

- ⦿ Why? CPIF contains directives to review implemented Consensus Policies, but with no specificity
