## Invitation to Provide Input – ICANN Community

On behalf of the Generic Names Supporting Organization (GNSO) Council, we are writing to provide you with an update and seek your feedback on the proposed implementation documents for PDP 3.0, a GNSO Council initiative aimed to enhance the efficiency and effectiveness of GNSO policy development processes. The <u>GNSO Council response</u> to the "Next Steps to Improve the Effectiveness of ICANN's Multistakeholder Model" public comment contains background of the PDP 3.0 initiative and details of our implementation process.

As of today, the GNSO Council has received the implementation documents for ten (10) out of the fourteen (14) PDP 3.0 improvements.
