As specified Section 1.7.2.1 of the ICANN Response to NTIA RFP Solicitation No: SA1301-12-RP-0043 located at <http://www.ntia.doc.gov/other-publication/2012/icann-proposal> , a "Contingency and Continuity of Operations Plan" exists since relating to the IANA Functions.
