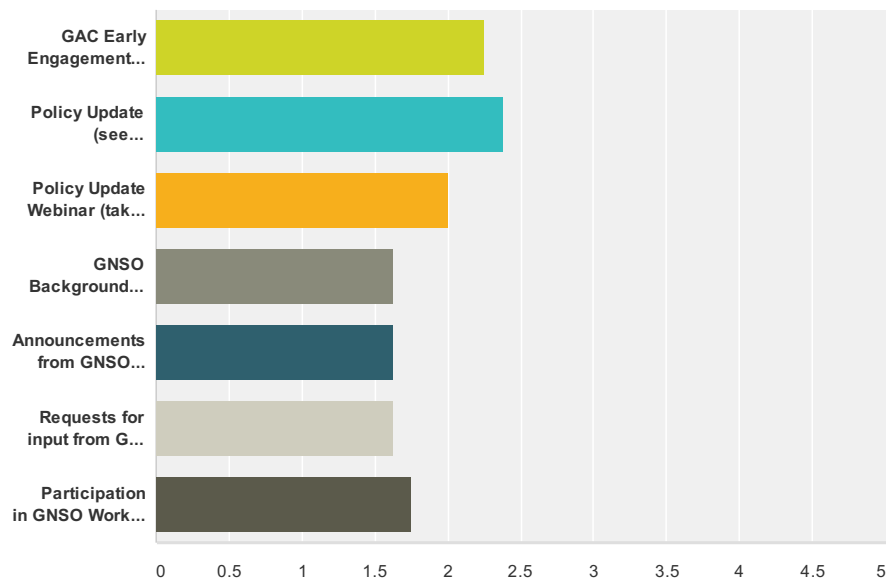


Q1 How familiar are you with the following existing mechanisms?

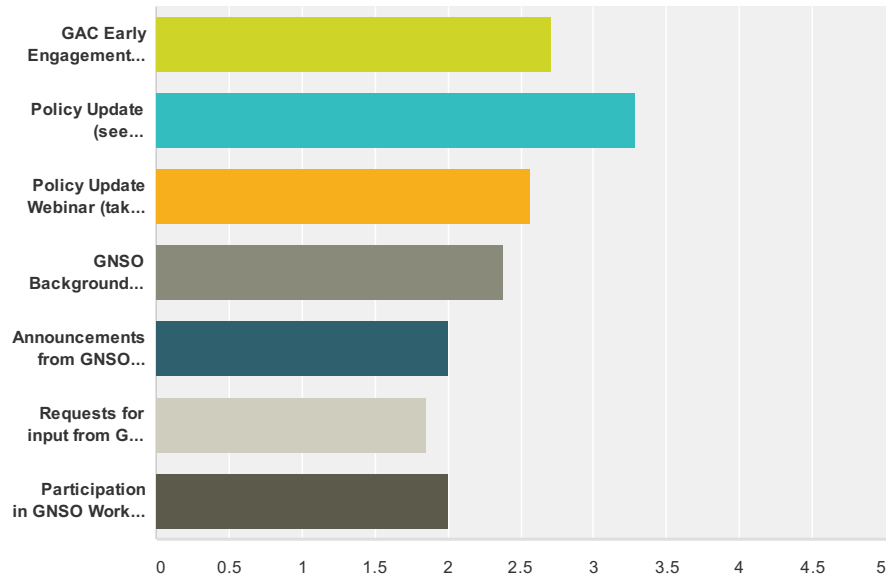

1	The GNSO website generally works well in presenting information about active projects. I suggest a home page quick link directly to "Main Policy Activities" which seems rather buried under a second link. The Main Policy summaries surprisingly (IDNs, WHOIS....) make no reference to the GAC: I suggest highlighting upfront those policy activities which require liaison with and significant inputs from the GAC and expected potential degree of interest - e.g. GAC should be aware / discussion with GAC expected / requires GAC public policy input. The GAC website should mirror this description of cross-community policy interest and in turn provide links to the GNSO summaries. This would help avoid undesirable silo effects and highlight commonality of priorities between the GNSO and the GAC.	7/10/2014 4:57 PM
