Revisions to procedures, if necessary.

# SOLUTION

<u>Recommendation 26</u>: Currently Chapter 5.0 Statements of Interest states that the definition of a "Relevant Party" to which the requirements apply includes: "the GNSO Council, or a work team, working group, <u>committee [emphasis added]</u> or other such policy development body formed by and under the supervision of the GNSO Council." <u>Staff notes that although the phrase "executive</u> committee" is not specifically called out as a Relevant Party, the word "committee" is listed that thus could be considered to include "Executive Committee" members. Staff further notes that the Statements of Interest of GNSO Council and Stakeholder Group and Constituency leadership are document on the GNSO site. See attachment A, below.

In addition, the current Chapter 5.0 states that the Statement of Interest must provide the following information, "Are there any arrangements/agreements between you and any other group, constituency or person(s) regarding your participation as a work team member? Please answer "yes" or "no." If the answer is "yes," please describe the arrangements/agreements and the name of the group, constituency, or person(s)." Thus, it is already a requirement that such relationships must be posted. As for the disclosure requirement of the recommendation, staff suggests that this is addressed with the responses to the following two questions:

- 5. Do you believe you are participating in the GNSO policy process as a representative of any individual or entity, whether paid or unpaid? Please answer "yes" or "no." If the answer is "yes," please provide the name of the represented individual or entity. If professional ethical obligations prevent you from disclosing this information, please so state.
- <u>6.</u> Please identify any other relevant arrangements, interests, or benefits as requested in the following two questions:
  - Do you have any type of material interest in ICANN GNSO policy development processes and outcomes? Please answer "yes" or "no." If the answer is "yes," please describe the material interest in ICANN GNSO policy development processes and outcomes.

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**Deleted:** Thus, Executive Committee members of Stakeholder Groups and Constituencies are not included in the requirement to complete and maintain a current, comprehensive Statement of Interest on the GNSO website.

**Deleted:** does not specifically state that where individuals represent bodies or clients, this information is to be posted. If not posted because of client confidentiality, the participant's interest or position must be disclosed. Failing either of these, the individual not be permitted to participate. However, the

**Deleted:** The GNSO Review Working Group should review the current language and determine whether it should be revised. Per the recommendation, Chapter 5.0 would need to be revised to include "Executive Committee members of Stakeholder Groups and Constituencies" in the definition of "Relevant Party." Staff can provide draft language for the Working Group to consider.

Recommendation 27: A centralized publicly available list of members and individual participants of every Constituency and Stakeholder Group (with a link to the individual's Statement of Interest where one is required and posted) exists, In addition, lists of members and individual participants of every Constituency and Stakeholder Group have been publicly since at least Fiscal Year 2015, if not earlier. See Attachment B. These all are available in a centralized place on gnso.icann.org,

<u>Recommendation 28</u>: Section 6.1.2 Membership of Chapter 6.0 Stakeholder Groups and Constituencies: Operating Principles and Participation Guidelines of the GNSO Operating Procedures should be revised to clarify that key clauses are mandatory rather than advisory, and to institute meaningful sanctions for non-compliance where appropriate. With respect to the first part of this recommendation, "that key clauses are mandatory", staff notes that when these procedures were developed by the Operations Steering Committee (OSC) as part of the GNSO Improvements Implementation, the OSC members specifically used the terminology "should" instead of "must" in Chapter 6.0, but meant the term to be considered a mandate, as opposed to optional. Thus, it is not clear what must be changed in section 6.1.2 that would make key clauses mandatory as they are already considered to be so. With respect to the second aspect of this recommendation Staff notes that to a degree sanctions and compliance monitoring do exist:

- Council and Stakeholder Group and Constituency Leadership Administrative Support maintain the GNSO site for leadership changes and will collaborate with individuals to have their <u>Statements of</u> <u>Interest</u> complete upon changes to leadership. While the <u>Stakeholder Group and Constituency</u> leadership <u>Statement of Interest</u> requirements in the <u>GNSO Operating Procedures</u> are not authoritatively defined, <u>Jeaders</u> have always completed <u>Statements of Inerest</u> as posted on the <u>GNSO</u> site.
- Working Group Participation at the start of each Working Group or new additions to existing Working Groups, members are required to meet <u>Statement of Interest</u> requirements for <u>Working Group</u> participation. After several weeks of non-compliance, a member will be reduced to observer until complance is met. Lastly, each formal WG call or GNSO Council meeting, the first agenda item is to as for any updates of <u>Statements of Interest</u>.

<u>Recommendation 29</u>: Current Statements of Interest of GNSO Council Members and Executive Committee members of all Stakeholder Groups and Constituencies do not include the total number of years that person h held leadership positions in ICANN. Per the recommendation, Chapter 5.0 Statement of Interest would need t be modified to include the requirement to provide the total number of years that person has held leadership positions. <u>However</u>, Staff notes that this recommendation will be difficult <u>if not impossible to currently</u> implement as the text is stated here. Perhaps staff can suggest, if there are changes to <u>the Statement of</u> <u>Interest</u> forms, that a "Start Date" field be listed within the <u>Statement of Interest</u>. This way the system can calculate the total years from Current Date – Start Date = Current # of Years.

# General:

Staff notes also that the <u>Statement of Interest</u> platform will migrate from the current wiki solutions to that of the Global Enrollment platform. This will allow for proper connection to individual's profiles and when they enroll in W<u>orking Group</u> and better alignment of the <u>Statement of Interest</u> to the <u>Working Group</u> entry into the system. <u>Unofficial</u> target date for launch is <u>Fiscal</u> Year <u>19</u>.
