Mary Wong:per Berry's note, what shows up in Whois depends on whether the name was allocated
Berry Cobb:and if not allocated, and a Brand Owner checks the Whois, I think how the name shows it is reservered varies across Registries. So it could perhaps be confusing to determine the ultimate status of the name.
Susan Payne:yes please
J. Scott:@Susan point.
Mary Wong:end date was also much more commonly offered than start date
Mary Wong:30 day advance notice was mandatory for start date
Mary Wong:yes we do (numbers)
Mary Wong:and we also know which gTLD ran which

Mary Wong:for numbers, we therefore know how many gtlds did each type and total registrations in each

Berry Cobb:But to Mary's point, we can not determine which names were registered when within either a start date or end date sunrise

Mary Wong:berry, yes

Susan Payne:agree

J. Scott:I think these questions need some more thinking

J. Scott:around what we are trying to get at

Cyntia King:I don't like asking this question as an eithe/or. I believe they should have the option to keep thw status quo.
