This document proposes the code-point repertoire for Assamese.

The color code convention followed is as follows:

For the current work-at hand, visiting the links 1 and 2 should be sufficient.

The MSR-2 is based on Unicode 7.0 and the charts that we have given are Unicode 6.3 due to the charting software limitation. However the single character (U+0980 - BENGALI ANJI

Also called as siddham or siddhirastu) added to the Bengali script block in Unicode 7.0 is barred by the Integration Panel and is marked as such in pink color.

The color coding conventions followed are similar to the ones used in the MSR-2 with the addition of blue marking to the characters barred by the Neo-brahmi GP.
