The RDS-WHOIS2 Review Team undertook the following during this session:

**1. Welcome, roll-call, Sol updates**

There were no updates to Statements of Interests.

**2. ICANN62**

ICANN org presented the draft engagement session slides and received input from the review team on updates needed. Each subgroup presentation layout included: a context setting slide, a slide on major findings, a slide on issues called out by the subgroup and a slide on recommendation(s) (if any).

Decisions Reached: The slides should be considered as guidance. No time for detailed presentation at engagement session.

Action Item: Subgroup rapporteurs to send any edits they may have on engagement slide-deck by 20 June, 15:00 UTC.

**3. Subgroups Status Update**

Three subgroups were invited to provide an update on their progress:

**Rec #3 – Outreach:** Alan Greenberg provided an update on the latest subgroup findings and recommendations.

Decision Reached: Rec. 2 to remain and list outreach targets (including GDPR data subjects) and importance of cost effectiveness.

Action item: Alan to update Rec. 2 in subgroup report to reflect above agreement; ICANN Org to update this recommendation on the engagement session subgroup's slide to match updated subgroup report.

**Rec #5-9 – Data Accuracy:** Lili Sun provided an update on the latest subgroup findings and pending discussions within the subgroup.

Action Item: Lili Sun to update subgroup draft report based on the three main problems were raised:

- 1) Lack of policy definition of 'Accuracy' (Refer to SAC058 for definitions used by ARS)
- 2) Identity theft as envisioned by the first review team is still an issue that has not been addressed by this review team
- 3) The problem that WHOIS users cannot tell to what level WHOIS data has been verified or when.

**Subgroup 5 – Safeguarding Registrant Data:** Alan Greenberg provided an update on the latest subgroup report, asking input from the review team on submitted recommendations.

Action item: Alan to update safeguarding registrant data subgroup report based on discussions; ICANN Org to update engagement slide (as appropriate) to match updated subgroup report.
