### 23 Feb 2012 Highlights

- Consensus views on N3, N4
  - Deliberately fraudulent use of the TMCH should bar those users from TMCH.
  - Desire to be able to challenge sunrise registrations based on lack of bona fide use.
  - Annual renewal and updates of information
    - Similar to existing domain renewal processes
  - Lighten the update burden for rights holders.
- The comment period for N3, N4 is now closed.

#### "Identical Match"

"Identical Match" means that the domain name consists of the complete and identical textual elements of the mark. In this regard:

- a. spaces contained within a mark that are either replaced by hyphens (and vice versa) or omitted;
- b. only certain special characters contained within a trademark are spelled out with appropriate words describing it (@ and &);
- c. punctuation or special characters contained within a mark that are unable to be used in a second-level domain name may either be (i) omitted or (ii) replaced by spaces, hyphens or underscores and still be considered identical matches; and
- d. no plural and no "marks contained" would qualify for inclusion.

#### N5: Matching Rules

- Clarifying questions:
  - What, if any, other characters beyond '&' and '@' should be able to have "rule B" translations?
  - Can a rights holder claim more than one "rule B" or "rule C" translation?
- Discussion Period
  - Which languages should be used in rule B? Why?
  - Should Registry or TMCH generate character mapping rule sets?
