Website Evaluation	<p>The UASG and Donuts have agreed to work cooperatively and share data. Other Measurement Activities – Browsers	While the number of browsers are limited, it was agreed that we should continue to pursue this project for completeness.	Don & Mark to identify a list of browsers to be evaluated.
Other Measurement Activities – Soft Measures	<p>While we had talk about soft measures before the Argentina meeting and at the Argentina meeting, there were no clear ideas of what reporting we want.</p> <p>We did note the work of the ICANN survey efforts on consumers and registrants, and we also noted the work the EurID has done in the middle-east.</p>	
Other Measurement – Who	<p>Once we get the lists and the definitions of UA Ready sorted, then we should go out and find someone who can do the work.</p> <p>We also talked about the nature of the skill set – and there was no argument that it would probably be a technical skillset. If this is the case, then we may see the same person/group to develop a solution – this is particularly true for the programming languages.</p> <p>We also talked about having a Bounty for getting programming languages (and other software) UA Ready. No decision was made one way or another.</p>
