From April 25-26 Sofia, Bulgaria hosted the <u>WebIT Festival</u> in the Sofia Tech Business Park. With over 5,000 attendees from around the world gathered in over a dozen parallel events, this was a great opportunity to meet a diverse cross section of web users. EURid, a sponsor of the event, had a booth which was placed right next to the SME Start-up stage and just across from the registration desk.



Promotional Work:

In addition to promoting the .eu and .eo TLDs, we also printed and handed out some <u>UASG documentation</u> to visitors of our booth. The varied audience, which included coders, entrepreneurs and representatives of government, meant that the topic of UA could be addressed from different levels.
