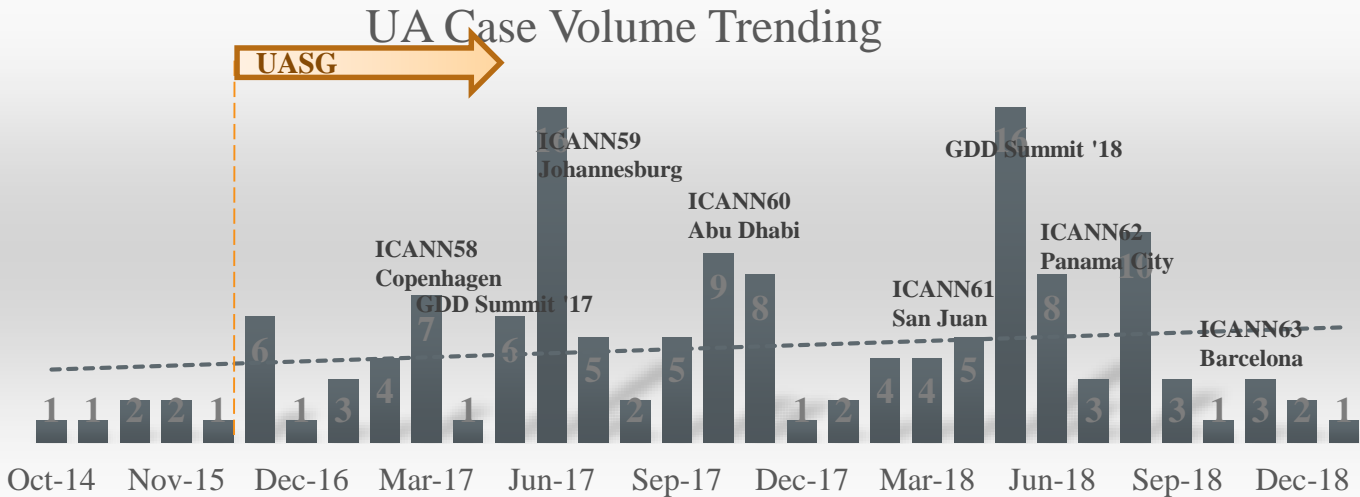

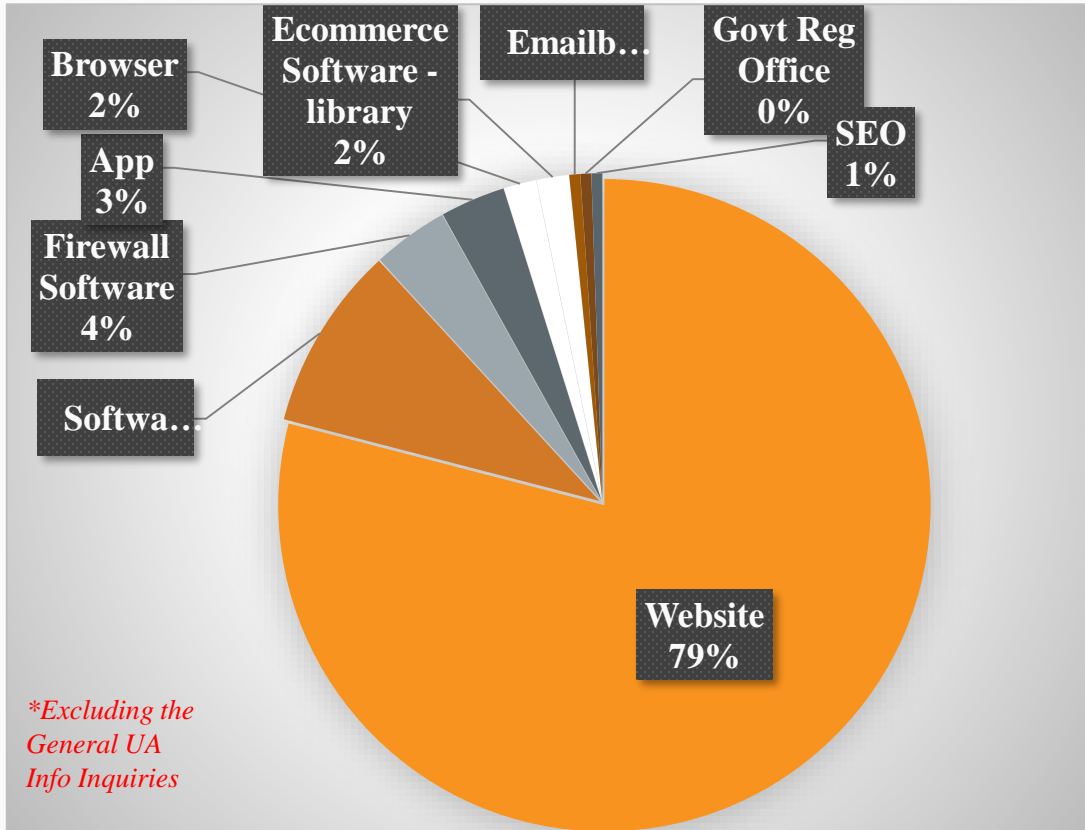
UA Issue Analysis

UA Ready – ICANN’s Commitment

- ⦿ ICANN’s Board has made improving and promoting UA and Internationalized Domain Name (IDN) implementation one of its five strategic priorities:
 - The rapid evolution of new technologies requires ICANN to be responsive to these changes and ensure that the unique identifiers system evolves and continues to serve the global Internet user base.” To help achieve this objective, ICANN is adding UA to the responsibilities of its Board IDN/UA Working Group.

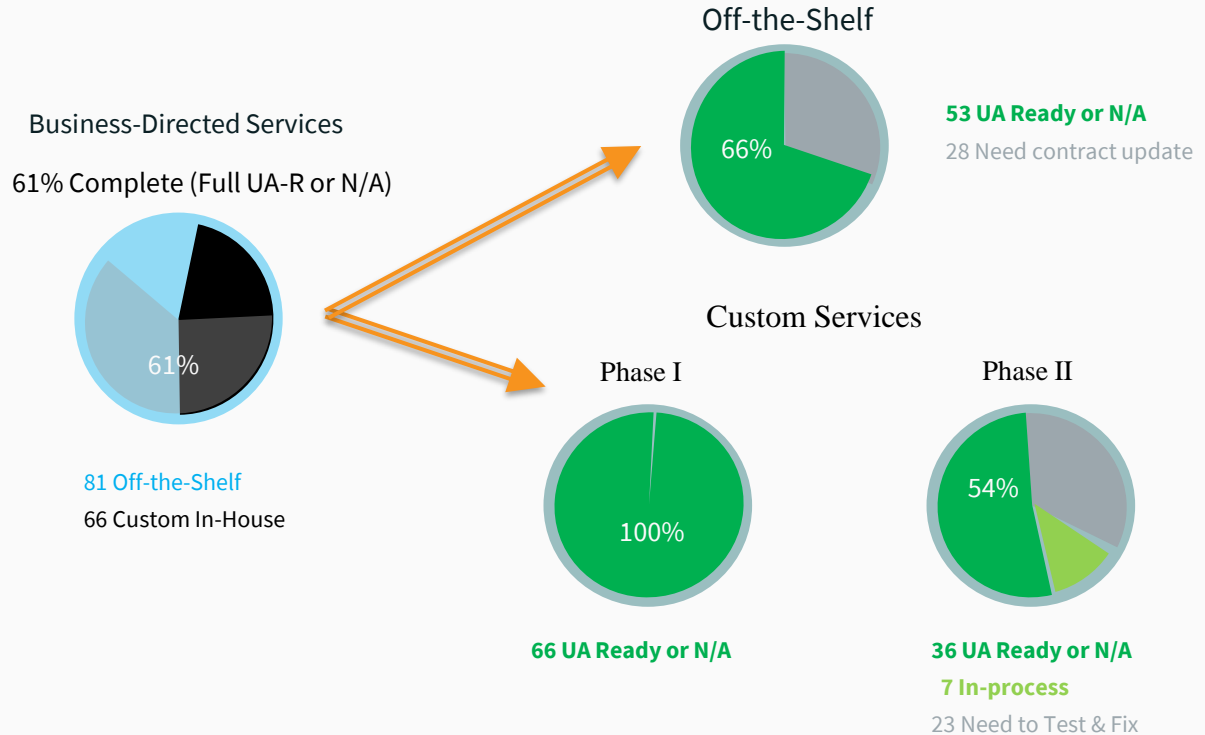
- ⦿ The UASG will continue to operate independently (it will remain a consortium of more than 120 companies, with its own budget), but will benefit from additional resources as well as increased support, visibility and alignment with ICANN’s Board.

UA Ready – ICANN’s Plan

- ⊙ Phase 1 (completed)
 - Accept and process long ASCII domain names
 - Handled mainly by Sustaining Engineering team
- ⊙ Phase 2 (in process)
 - We have preset definitions for changes required to be UA-R
 - We use the UASG IDN test sites and emails
 - We have code libraries around TLD use
- ⊙ Transitioning to EAI compliant Email (dependency on 3 party^{3rd})
 - Update our 3rd-party email systems to meet IDN requirements
- ⊙ Misc. (in place for years)
 - Require UA-Readiness in new off-shelf service selection criteria
 - Require UA-Readiness in all new custom services

EAI – Email Address

Internationalization

- Becoming UAA in our regular email use
 - Email client:
 - Outlook 2016 supports EAI
 - **Version installed**
 - Email server: Microsoft Exchange
 - Exchange 2019 supports EAI
 - Version available, upgrade requested/being scheduled
 - Routers/Gateways: Postfix (our vendor is Redhat)
 - Postfix 3.0 supports EAI
 - Redhat has scheduled the release for July 2019

EAI – Email Address

Internationalization

- ⊙ Becoming UAT Ready for international use
 - Security/Spam Filter: ProofPoint
 - EAI support not on the ProofPoint roadmap
 - We have escalated a request for EAI support
 - We are researching replacements
 - Archive/Backup: (ProofPoint)
 - EAI support not on the ProofPoint roadmap
 - We have escalated a request for EAI support
 - We are researching replacements
 - Once individual upgrades are completed, system-wide testing will be required before we can claim EAI support

UA-Ready: Requirements for Purchased Solutions

- ⊙ First confirm whether or not service will handle domain names and/or emails
- ⊙ If so, service must be UA-Ready
 - Handle long ASCII-based domain names and emails
 - Handle EAI in any language (switch to Unicode for display)
 - Switch hot-links to Punycode (ASCII-based Unicode)
 - Proof of testing
 - If not UA-Ready yet, where is it on the roadmap?
