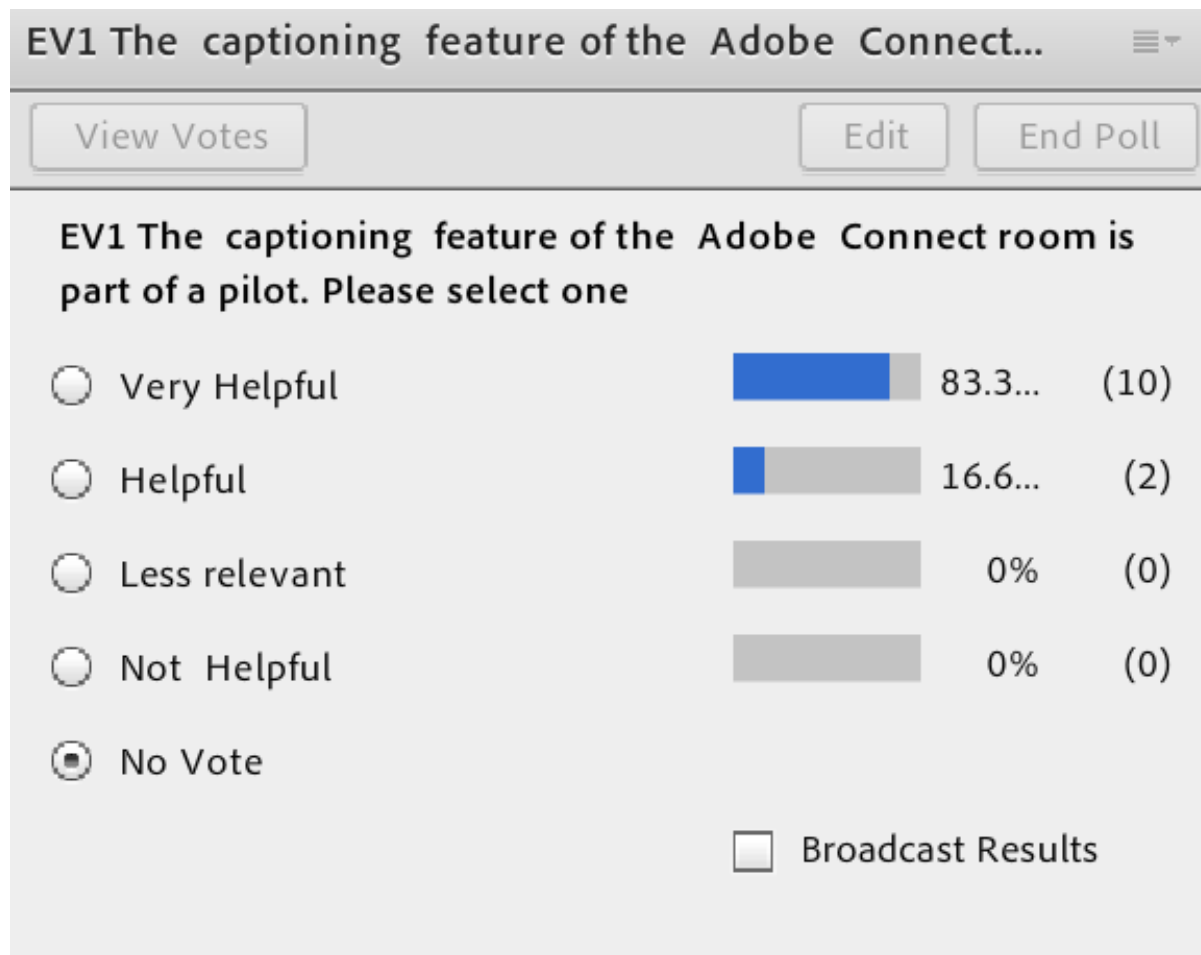
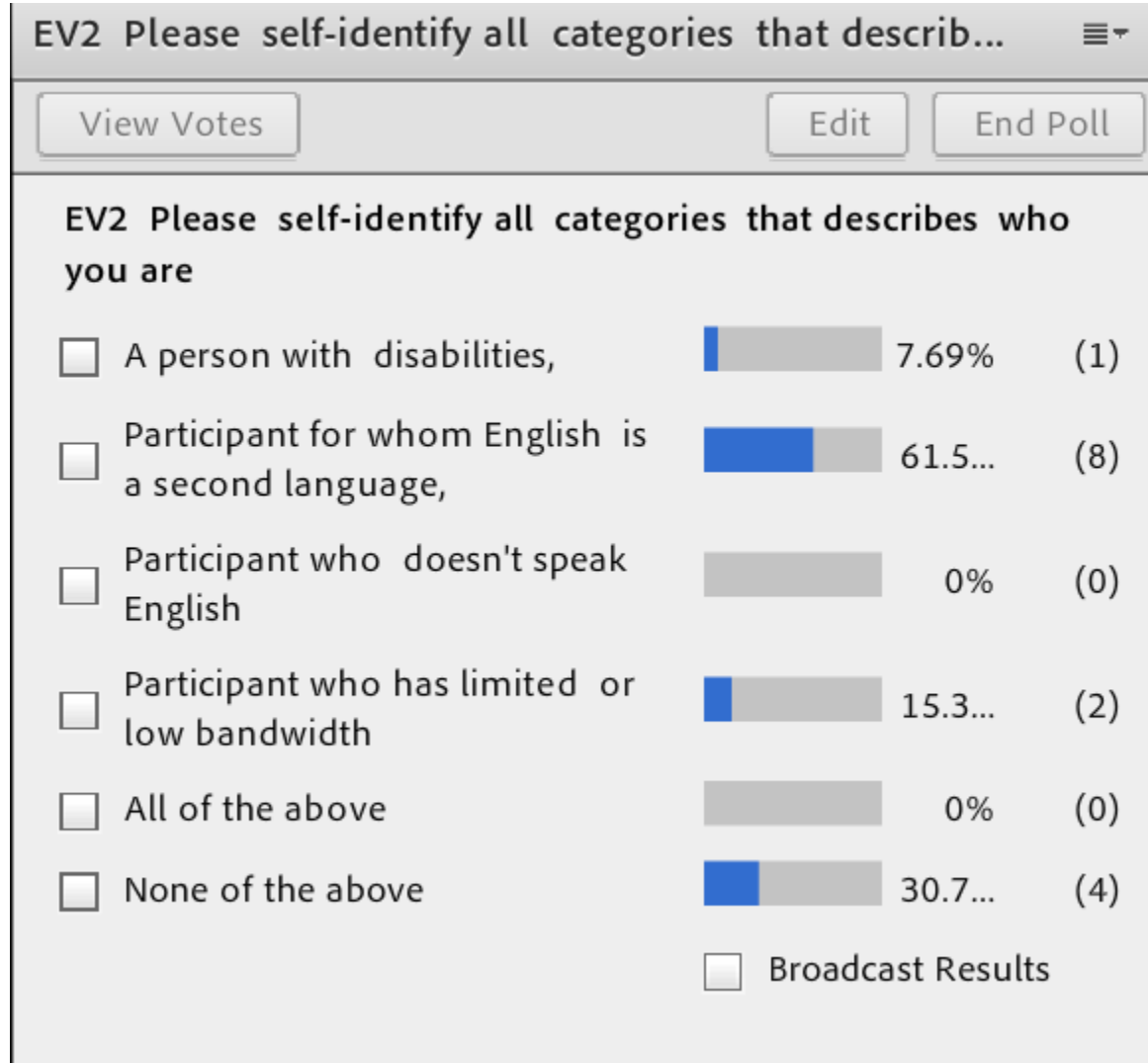
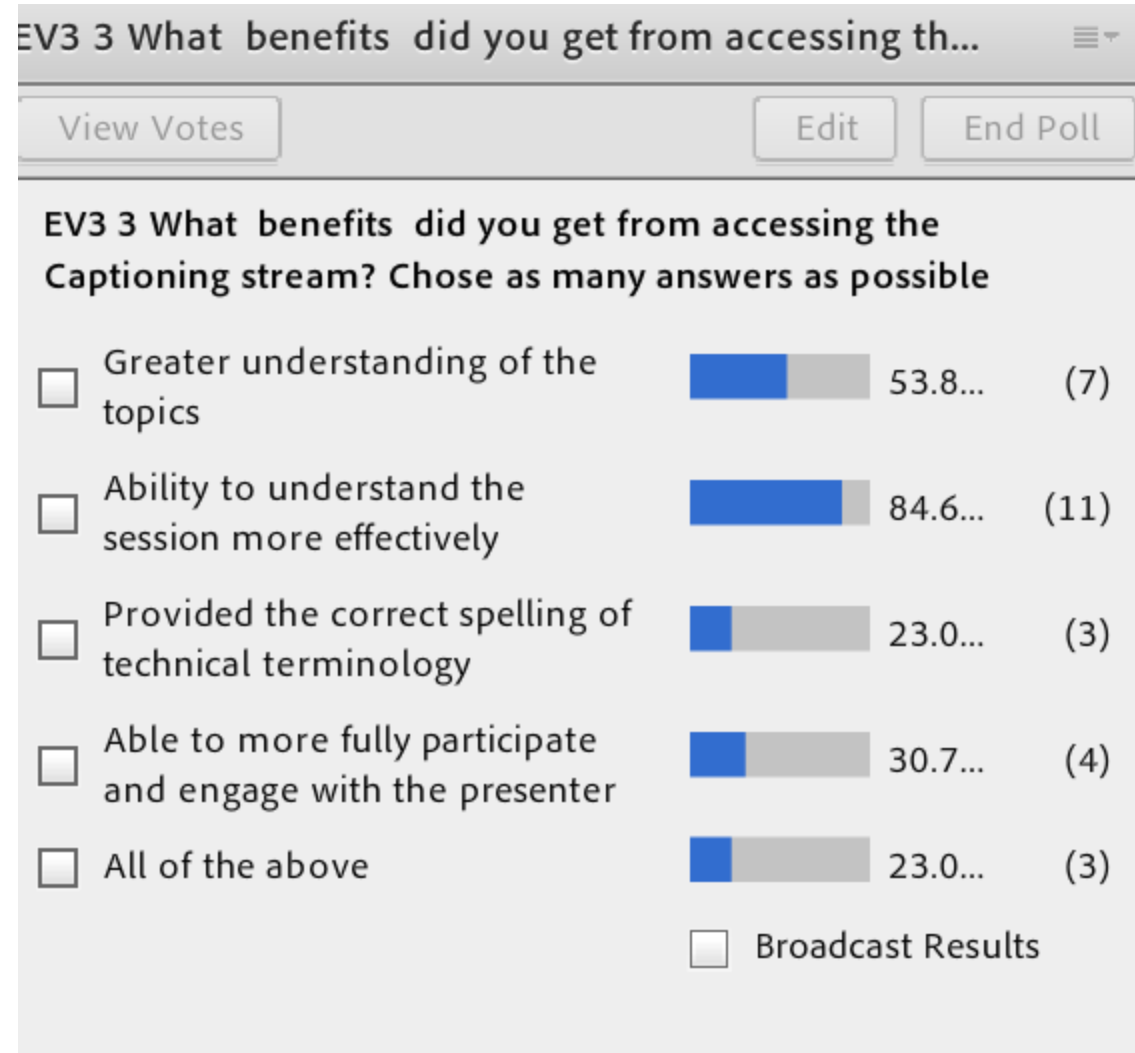

I could join w/ low bandwidth and answered my doubts on terminology

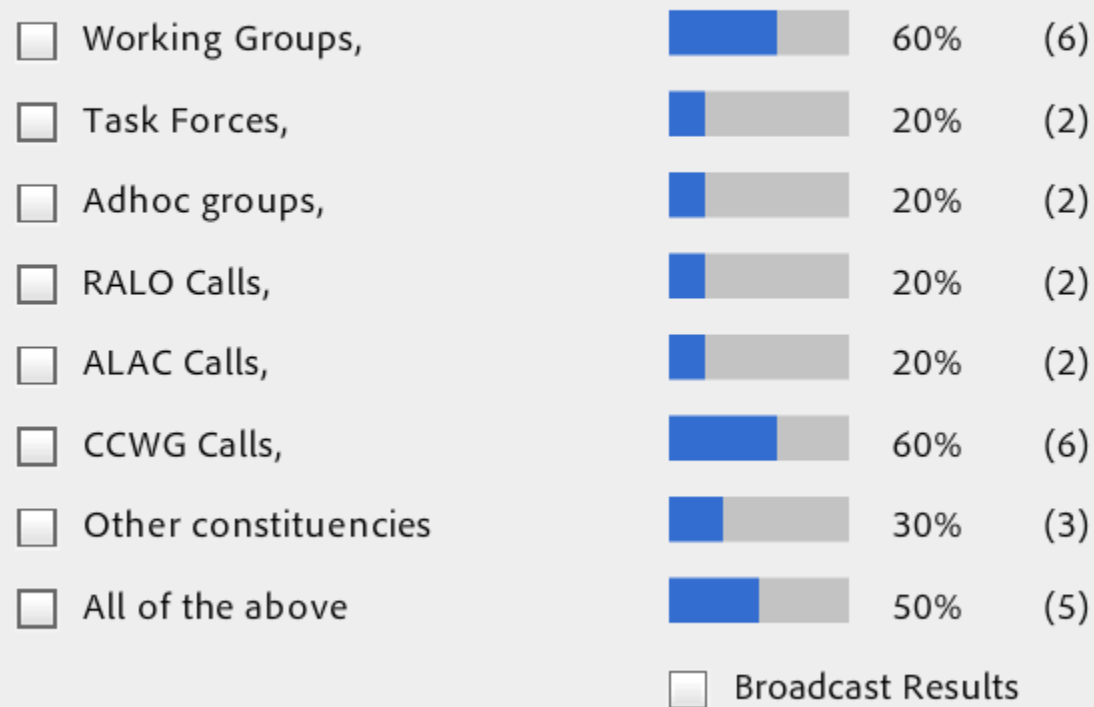
helps you to understand what is being said-especially when the audio is unclear
