# SO/ACs, Constituencies, Board (7)

- ALAC supports recs; no comment on OOD; emphasizes language support
- SSAC supports recs; does not support OOD
- BC supports recs; no comment on OOD; some suggestions relevant to implementation
- IPC supports recs; no comment on OOD
- NCSG supports recs; no comment on OOD (but notes external expertise may be required to support metrics); supports common, basic toolkit of criteria, metrics, and score card (Rec3)
- RySG general support for recs with few suggestions (below); does not support OOD; some suggestions relevant to implementation
  - Rec1 suggests amending to "should agree";
  - o Rec 5 annual assessment update too frequent;
  - Rec 7 'ICANN staff should support the SO/AC/Groups in developing and publishing a process for dealing with diversity related complaints and issues.'
- Board supports recs; does not support OOD; highlights that privacy and resource issues need to be considered

## Governments (2)

- French Govt supports recs; supports OOD
- Indian Govt supports recs; no comment on OOD; emphasizes language support; some comments relevant to implementation

- Akinremi Peter Taiwo supports recs; supports OOD
- Chokri Ben Romdhane implied support for recs; suggestions re SSAC appt process
- Ghislain De Salins supports recs; supports OOD or independent advisory panel
- Jorge.Cancio supports comments made by Ghislain de Salins
- Sebicann Bachollet supports comments made by Ghislain de Salins
- International Trademark Assn supports recs; no comment on OOD

#### **Summary:**

- All Public Comments provide general support for the recs.
- RySG suggest some helpful specific wording changes which should be discussed
- Only support for OOD comes from 5 individuals and 1 Government; none from SO/ACs, Constituencies or Board
- Some helpful suggestions relevant to implementation; Sub-Team should identify these, list them and provide feedback that these will be highlighted for consideration during implementation.
