Scenario/stress Testing

- Step 1: Develop Scenario's (meeting 1&2)

- Step 2: Impact of the policy.

How does scenario play out under the policy. What would be result of the scenario under the policy?

- Step 3: Assessment of impact

Does the outcome of step 2 result in an unwanted outcome or unforesee negative side effect? If so, does the policy need to be adjusted?

Step 2 and Step 3 are combined

Example of scenario: Change of Name of Territory

ÆccTLD has been delegated to country Alfa.

A few years after the delegation Alfa changes its name from Alfa to B, and in doing so the designated language and script change as well: in short ÆccTLD does not meet multiple IDNccTLD selection criteria anymore.

After the name change of the country, B requests the delegation of the newly assigned two-letter code (.bq, the ASCII ccTLD), which is also advertised and promoted. However it has not requested nor intends to request a new IDNccTLD.

How will this play out under the policy? Is the outcome an issue?

Example of scenario: When will an IDNccTLD be De-Selected?

Assume country A has in the past selected 2 IDN ccTLD strings (\mathbb{A} ccTLD & AccTLD), which were both valid at the time of application.

\mathbb{A} ccTLD is still in a designated language and related script, however the other one (AccTLD) is no longer the case in a designated language of Country A.

Now, assume that another country or territory (AA) applies for AAIDN ccTLD string that does meet the criteria, however AccTLD has not been de-selected (*no confirmation was requested*).

How will this play out under the policy? Is the outcome an issue?

Can a requestor from AA request AccTLD?

Step 1: develop scenario's

Scenario: a description of possible events, or a description of the story of a movie, play, or other performance.

Method:

- 3 Zoom Break-out rooms:
 - Appoint spokesperson per zoom room
 - 2 minutes to think about scenario
 - 15 minutes to record
 - Use Jamboard: Staff to record scenario with sticky notes
- Presentation scenario's: Each group to present scenario's 5 minutes to present per group and Q&A (for clarification)
- Combine and cluster scenario's Next meeting

Step 2 & 3 per scenario (next meetings)

- Starting with a scenario, individually consider scenario and how it would play out under the policy (individually)
- Group to describe the outcome
- Assessment of the outcome
