


NPOC SURVEY ANALYSIS


Below you will find the results from the different questions in our survey. The first thing that we should to say is that there was not more than 10 members who answer the questions. This report for EC is not looking to show trends due to its nature, but it could be a good material to have some guide in order to know what our members prefer.

The first question it was about the region in what our members are, the most active members were from Africa, North America, Europe and Latin America, there were no members from Asia, Asia Pacific or the Caribbean who answer the survey.


The next question it was about age diversity. Just 37% is between 40 and 50 years old, and the rest are belonging to the ranges from 20 to more than 80 years.



Our gender diversity is predominant by males in a percentage of 75% contrasted with 25% of females




The following question it was about how many times have been involved in our Constituency. In this case the most people who answer have been involved from 3 to 5 years (37.5%), and in equal proportion we can find those who have been more than 5 years and between 1 and 3 years (25%)




The next question is one of most interesting ones due to we can note what are our members considering as a challenge to participate actively, in which we can find thoughts as “Lack of experience”, “Lack of broader participation (by members) in collaborative approaches to NPOC tasks, i.e., failure to make ad hoc teams to handle writing, comments, etc.”, “Lack of information reaching us, lack of opportunities to participate in meetings”, “Lack of time for calls, Lack of time for active participation e.g. committee work, Insufficient knowledge of the issues and of the policy development process”


In any case our members want to be actively involved with us mainly writing Policy Statements, and then being member of NPOC’s Committees



The next question about what Committee would they like to join show us the Policy Committee as the most wanted, Membership and Outreach were the next options selected by our members.




As the good news can be read our next question about the priority topics of the operational concerns because all of them, except one, will have personal interested into develop in our Constituency




In the scale about how useful our priority topics for our members we are can find Privacy as the most useful topic for them, followed by Domain Name Fraud, how to write Policy Statements, Security, Stability and Resiliency and Transparent Registration

On a scale from 'very useful' to 'Not at all useful', please rate how relevant each topic is to you. By relevance, we mean how appropriate is for you. The more you useful the topic is appropriate to you, the higher you would rate it.



When we ask about their experience writing policy statements in a scale from 1 to 5, the average it was 3, what show us that our members don't have many experience on this topic.



As suggestions the members who respond propose: "Need to enlist national associations of NGO's in an educational campaign to explain important of ICANN work to their reality, then seek membership", "Development of an alternative to list-serves for communications, especially creating a workspace for developing and writing policy, such as Slack.", "Involve new people, it is always the same 6-7 people we hear about, attending all the meetings. Very discouraging", "Identify activities that the members can get involved in. Ensure the members calls are regular and consistent and have content of interest to members."
