Re: Proposed Amendment to the .org Registry-Registrar Agreement.

Dear Mr. Betremieux:

As we previously discussed, Public Interest Registry (“**PIR**”) would like to make a minor amendment to the .org Registry-Registrar Agreement (“**RRA**”). Specifically, we would like to lower the insurance requirement contained in Section 7.1 of the RRA from \$1,000,000.00 USD to \$500,000.00 USD. This change is intended to have the .org RRA insurance requirements reflect the insurance requirements currently imposed on registrars by the 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement. We have attached a redline of the RRA for ICANN’s review and approval reflecting this proposed change. For the sake of clarity, we have also updated the Domain-Name Initial Registration Fee and the Domain-Name Renewal Fee (contained in Exhibit A of the RRA) to reflect our current pricing for .org domains.
