

Dear ICANN,

In accordance with section 2.9(a) of the Registry Agreement, we would like to advise you that we have made the following amendments to our RRA for .GLOBAL.

- Section 4.1 : We have reduced the notice period from 6 months for price increases for initial registrations, renewals and transfers to 60 days for initial registrations and 180 days for renewals and transfers. This brings the notice period for price increases more in line with section 2.10 of the Registry Agreement.
- Section 10.2 : We have updated the email address in the notices section to notices@nic.global.
- Exhibit A: Registration Fees and Payment
The price list has been removed from this Exhibit, and is replaced with a reference to the .GLOBAL Price List. The definitions of the Fees has been reformatted accordingly. The reason behind this change is so that the Price List may be changed without needing ICANN approval as per section 2.9 of the Registry Agreement. The Registry Operator will still be required to provide prior notice to Registrars for any price increases as per section 2.10 of the Registry Agreement and section 4.1 of Registry-Registrar Agreement.

The following changes are minor corrections to the RRA agreement.

- Section 1.13 : Remove the duplicate text “operator”
- Section 1.14 : Remove “Afilias Ltd or” to just specify the generic reference to a specific Registry Service Provider
- Section 2.11 : Change license to licence

Attached is the redline version of the above changes to the RRA.
