Key Characteristics

Single member LLC with a distinct board

RSSAC both becomes an advisory group to this board and picks one third of the seats. This parallels the IAB, which is both helps constitute and advises the ISOC Board. Other seats by ICANN NomCom and other stakeholder groups.

Holds one end of the MoUs and/or contracts with Root Server Operators.

Decides to build/buy performance monitoring.

Board decides whether to spin up review panels based on MoU/Contract language or notification by operator.

Review panels are multistakeholder.
