For MTA.12: Nitin questioned whether it is good to have MTA.12 as it looks like it is contradicting to RFC. This item will be checked with J. Levine. We will verify the RFC whether this is required.

For MTA.13: The part in the description "the message must be rejected" was proposed to be changed as "the receiving MTA is expected to reject the message, and the sending MTA must detect that rejection". This suggestion will be verified with John Levine.



Mark standardized the note that is included in MTA.8 through MTA.13 as: "NOTE: This only applies to MTAs which are separate from an MSA, which is not typical."

Empty cells in MDA table was filled out. MDA Table was reviewed in detail and "should" expressions were updated as "must". Description of MDA.7 was simplified.

EAI Readiness Level no:7 was updated as "Hosting functionality for internationalized mailboxes is [available but] not enabled [by default]".

The team reviewed the guide until MDA.8. We will continue reviewing the table next week from MDA.8.
